START triage system

Initial Ribbon Triage

MINOR Able to walk on command, no major injuries.

DECEASED No respirations after head tilt.

IMMEDIATE Respirations after head tilt.

IMMEDIATE Respirations over 30 per minute.

IMMEDIATE Perfusion - Radial pulse absent.

IMMEDIATE Mental status - Unable to follow simple commands.

DELAYED All Others.

MORGUE Pulseless/Not Breathing

IMMEDIATE Life-Threatening Injury

DELAYED Serious Non Life-Threatening

MINOR Walking Wounded

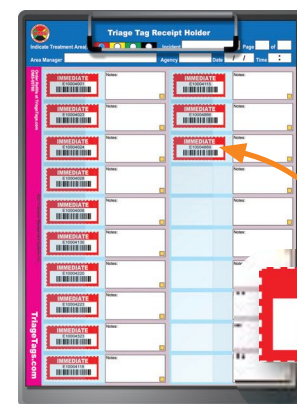

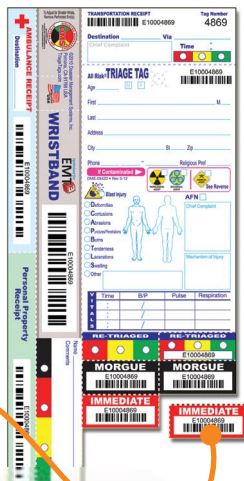
