



Immediate Treatment Area Manager Job Action Sheet

Your job is to account for and treat patients entering your treatment area and to advise the **Casualty Care Unit Leader** when you have a patient that is stabilized and ready to ship.

Receiving Patients

- 1 When a **Porter** delivers a patient, assign a **Triage Tag** to the patient.
- 2 Once a patient has a tag, place the **Porter** in the **Porter Staging Area**.
- 3 Remove the tag's unnecessary acuity receipts to indicate it is an **Immediate** patient.
- 4 Remove one of the **Immediate** receipts and place it in the **patient accountability log**.
- 5 Document treatment provided to stabilize the patient. The patient is now ready to ship.
- 6 Advise the **Casualty Care Unit Leader** you have a patient ready to ship.

- 1 Use tag front and back to document condition and care.
